Our finest pile rug, Eik, represents the highest level of craftsmanship. The New Zealand wool is worsted using the longest fibres, spun in pairs for exceptional softness and resilience. The weave is tight, the pile deep, and the rug has a sense of pure understated luxury.

Eik has a unique flexible warp system with no glue. The structure moves and settles naturally with use, then recovers with an ultimate bounce-back effect. The pure materials give the rug a longer life and sustainable integrity.

The palette is grounded in nature, with six colours that feel quiet and lasting: two soft and pale tones, a moss green, a deep cinnamon, and two warm, coffee-inspired brown shades.

In every sense of the word, Jens Landberg Schrøder has designed a rug made to endure and create an exceptional ambience in any room. Quality you can feel the moment you step onto it.

Eik is available in sizes up to 300 x 400 cm, making it ideal for larger spaces and hospitality environments.

CERTIFICATION

Independent test results confirm performance at the highest industry standards.

Durability Most tested rugs achieve the highest classification for loose-laid textile floor coverings. The same rigorous test previously classified the rugs as Class 23 (Heavy Domestic Use) and, under the updated classification system, corresponds to Class 32 General Commercial Use. These results are a testament to our rugs' high durability and resilience in spaces with intensive daily use, maintaining both their appearance and material integrity over time.



BS EN 13501-1 Bfl-s1

Fire safety All tested designs achieve the highest fire classification for textile floor coverings, Class Bfl-s1. This ensures strong resistance to flame spread and minimal smoke emission, providing maximum safety in public and hospitality spaces. Testing is carried out in accordance with EN 13501-1, using internationally recognized methods including EN ISO 9239-1 and EN ISO 11925-2. Only a small number of rugs are not included in this testing programme, as they are designed for private homes rather than hospitality use.
