This design offers a timeless aesthetic and everyday durability with its quiet subtle graphic pattern that emerges through nuanced tones of straw, blush and sage. So soft that the pattern almost dissolves into texture. Hand-woven from high-quality New Zealand wool on a cotton warp, Picea is woven in a durable 4-ply twisted yarn, where the four strands create a strong, resilient design. The carefully blended wool colours give depth and richness to every shade, creating a surface that feels considered and bring a calm, grounded presence complementing a wide range of interiors.

CERTIFICATION

Independent test results confirm performance at the highest industry standards.

Durability Most tested rugs achieve the highest classification for loose-laid textile floor coverings. The same rigorous test previously classified the rugs as Class 23 (Heavy Domestic Use) and, under the updated classification system, corresponds to Class 32 General Commercial Use. These results are a testament to our rugs' high durability and resilience in spaces with intensive daily use, maintaining both their appearance and material integrity over time.

Fire safety All tested designs achieve the highest fire classification for textile floor coverings, Class Bfl-s1. This ensures strong resistance to flame spread and minimal smoke emission, providing maximum safety in public and hospitality spaces. Testing is carried out in accordance with EN 13501-1, using internationally recognized methods including EN ISO 9239-1 and EN ISO 11925-2. Only a small number of rugs are not included in this testing programme, as they are designed for private homes rather than hospitality use.

As most of our rugs are unique and hand-made, the size can vary slightly from the ordered size (+/-4%). Irregularities in size, colour and weaving are characteristics of hand-made rugs.

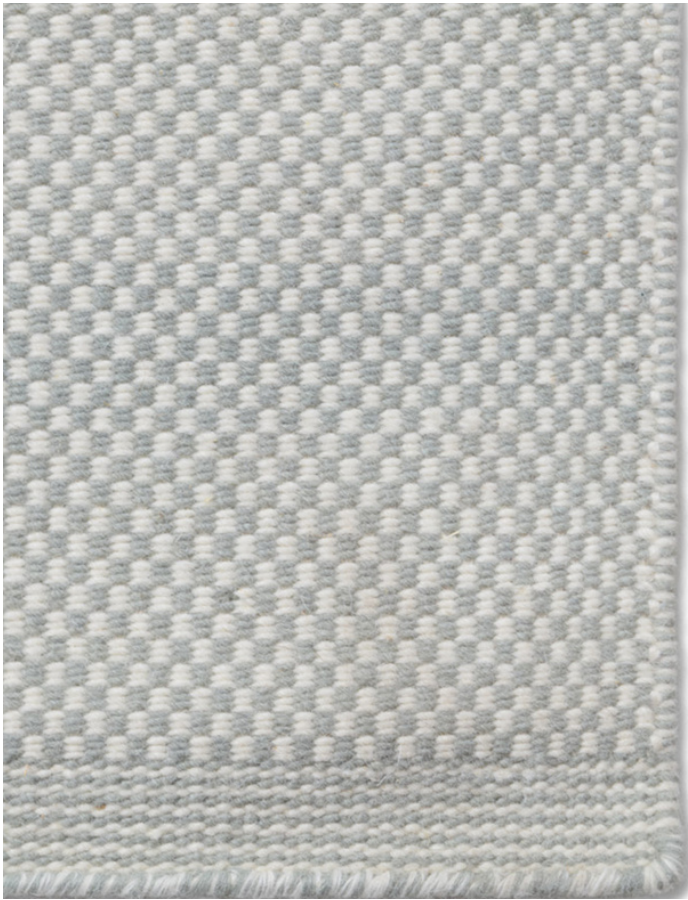

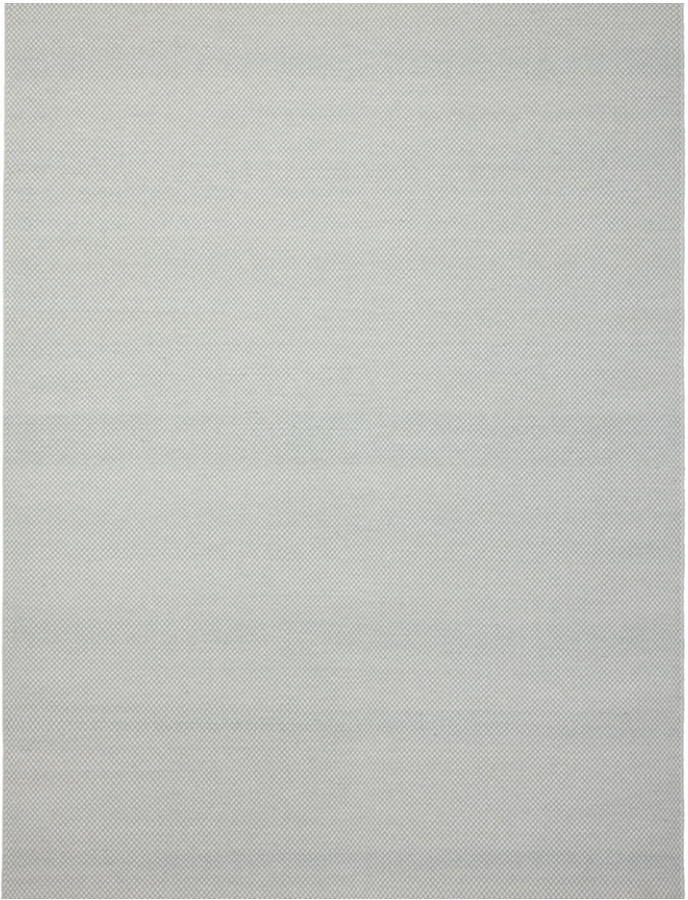
